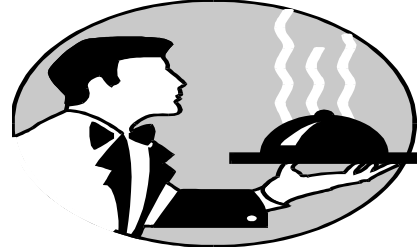

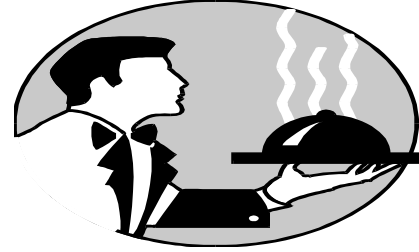


Directions: Introductory statement about the picture...

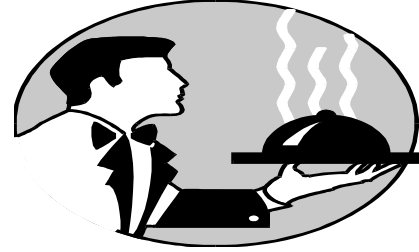


Directions: *Here are two pictures from story books about food service at two restaurant. Write a report that tells your teacher what is similar about both restaurants, and what is different about both restaurants.*

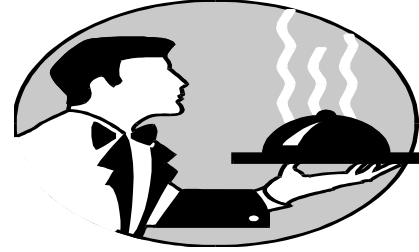

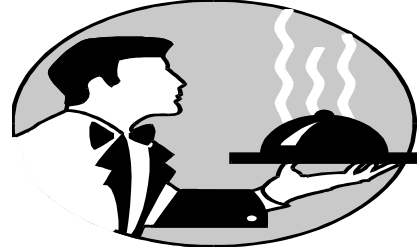

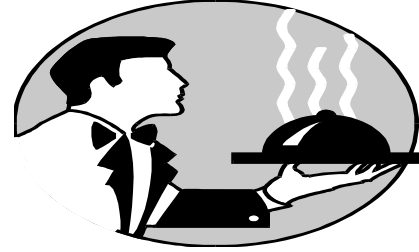
